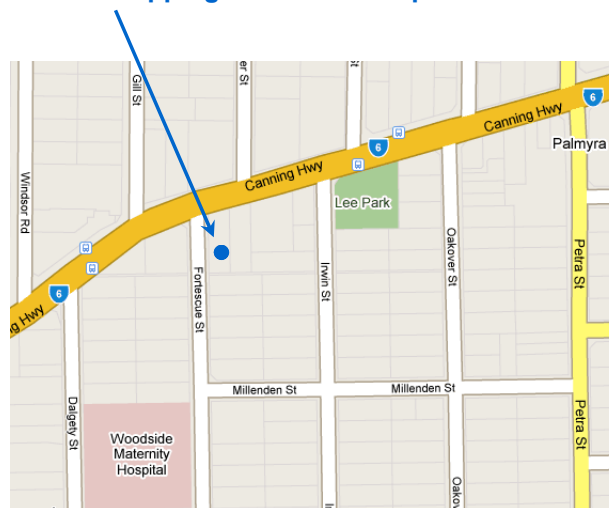

Kindergarten Structure

Each class will have a maximum of 20 children. Classes will be taught by a qualified teacher and teaching assistant.

The facility has two classrooms and a great outdoor play area with lots of toys and equipment for the children to play with and learn on.

Children will participate in a wide range of indoor and outdoor activities during both half-day and full-day sessions. These will include music, language development, storytelling, free play and gross and fine motor activities.

The Facility



The Stepping Stones Development Centre is architecturally designed and a purpose-built early childhood facility.

Ages of Children

Three-Year-Olds:

Children may begin classes at Stepping Stones Child Development Centre in the school term in which they turn three.

Four-Year-Olds:

Children may participate in full-day classes at the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn four.

Daily Requirements

When attending a session, children will need to come wearing sunscreen and bring along:

- a hat
- a bag
- a drink bottle
- a change of clothes
- a piece of fruit to share
- lunch (if enrolled in a full-day session)

Please ensure that your child's personal items are clearly and permanently labelled.

Registration Fee & Holding Deposit

The \$50 registration fee is a one off fee and goes towards administration and insurance costs. This fee is non-refundable.

The holding deposit will be a portion of your term fees, requested when you are offered a place, to hold your place for that term.
